Kenrokuen is one of the three most beautiful Japanese Gardens, which is known as a special scenic spot and famous for its strolling-style landscape garden. There are variety of cherry trees species in Kenrokuen, such as weeping cherry tree and double flowered cherry tree. Chirihama Nagisa Driveway is the only road of a sandy beach for vehicles.

Lake Biwa in Shiga Prefecture is Japan's largest lake with the surface area of 670 km². The lake is so large that it looks as if it is a sea. At Biwako Terrace, you can enjoy a magnificent view overlooking Lake Biwa. Kaizu Ozaki is one of famous sakura spot along the lake.



Osaka is called as the "Kitchen of the Nation" in Edo period. Please enjoy many kinds of local cuisines in Osaka, especially at Dotonbori, one of the hot spots.

Mint Bureau is famous for its sakura tunnel along a street in front of the brick building.
