Shirakawago / Takayama

Gujo Hachiman is used to a castle town in the past and the city remains its old streets. Explore the town and visit its famous food sample workshops. In January, sake breweries in Takayama start to open their breweries and sell fresh sakes.

Enjoy the ride of the double decker ropeway at Shin Hotaka, where you can see the beautiful scenery of mountains with snow. Shirakawago is the world heritage site that is surrounded by mountains and maintains its unique and traditional life-style.

Kenrokuen is one of the three most beautiful Japanese Gardens, which is known as a special scenic spot and famous for its strolling-style landscape garden. Visit Kittokito (fresh) Market and see a red carpet of snow crabs. Crab Auction for wholesales can only be seen during crab fishing season.



Kanazawa / Toyama / Tojinbo

The Kurokabe Square building was established during the Meiji period as a bank. Nowadays, it is used as a gallery for glassware, displaying and selling such items as glass accessories and music boxes. At night, enjoy Nabana no Sato winter illumination such as a light tunnel and a lit-up flower display.
