Ise Jingu is Japan's most sacred Shinto shrine dating back to the 3rd century. Okage Yokocho, which stood on the Ise pilgrimage road to Ise Jingu, visitors can enjoy tasting traditional food products in Mie and shopping local specialties. Also, enjoy a panoramic view of Ago Bay, ria coastline and pearlculture rafts on the water.



Kumano Nachi Taisha is one of the three Kumano shrines, situated a few kilometers island from the hot spring resort of Katsuura. The site is famous for Nachi no Taki, the tallest waterfall 133 meter in Japan. Beside Nachi Taisha, Kumano Kodo pilgrimage routes were registered as UNESCO World Heritage as part of the "Sacred Sites and Pilgrimage Routes in the Kii Mountain Range".

Shirahama is a resort area with beautiful beaches, onsens and scenic landscapes along the bay.

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Besides Nachi/Kumano, Mt. Koya's historical spots are also registered as parts of UNESCO sites.

Osaka is called as the "Kitchen of the Nation" in Edo period. Please enjoy many kinds of local cuisines in Osaka, especially at Dotonbori, one of the hot spots.
